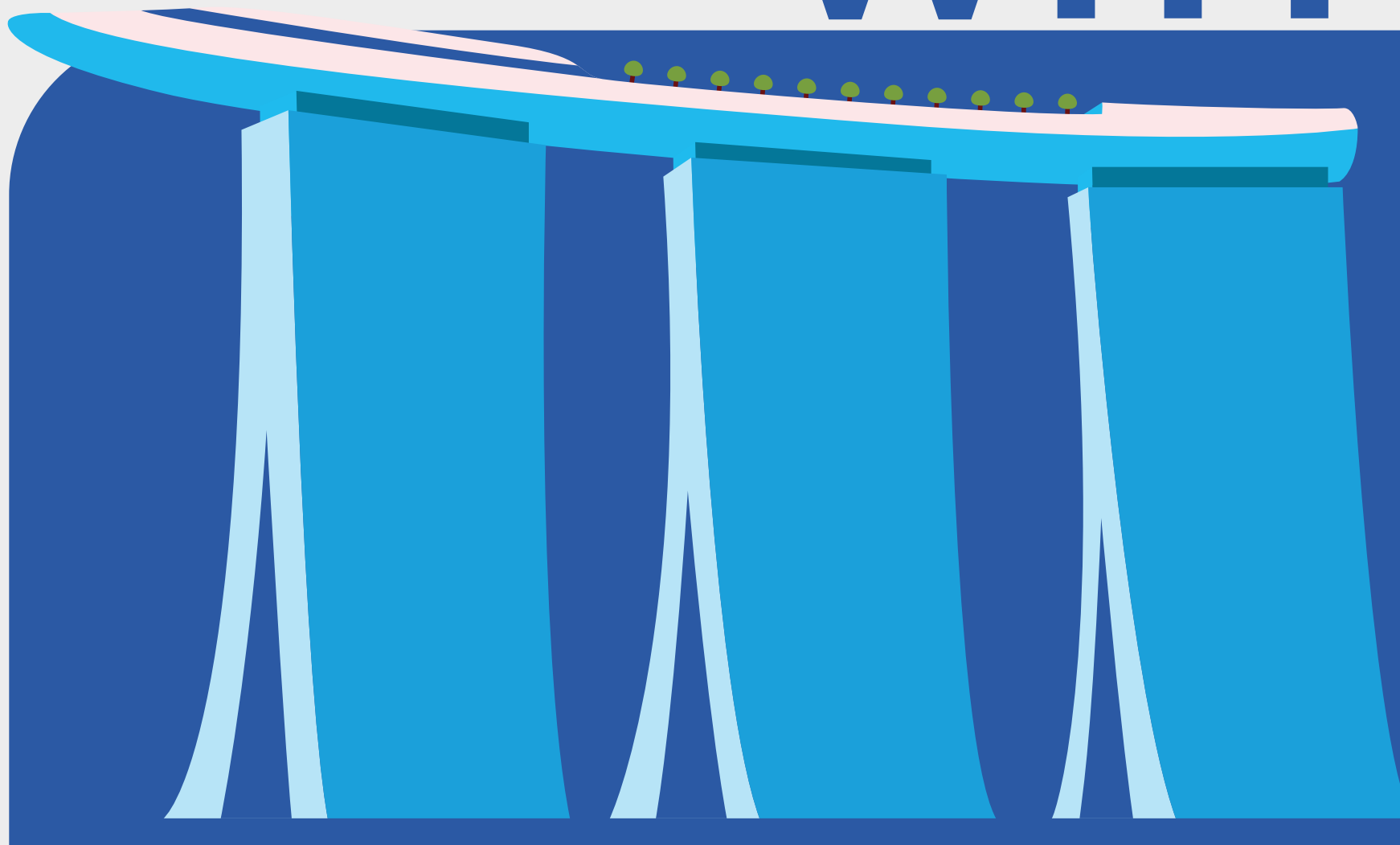

STRONG ECONOMY

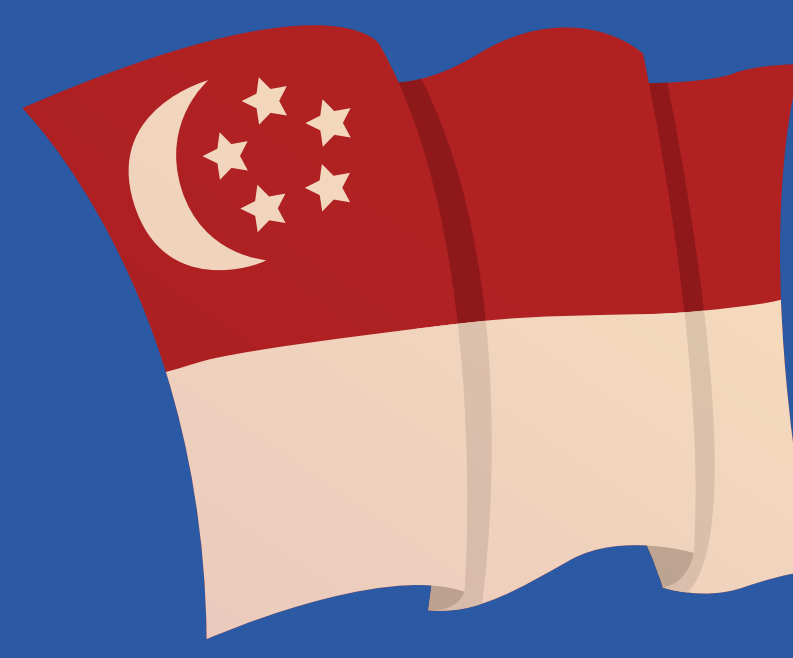
Amidst global economic headwinds, Singapore remains one of the world's strongest economies, making it an ideal hub from which to access the region and its fast growing consumer market.

Australia, UK & France 45%

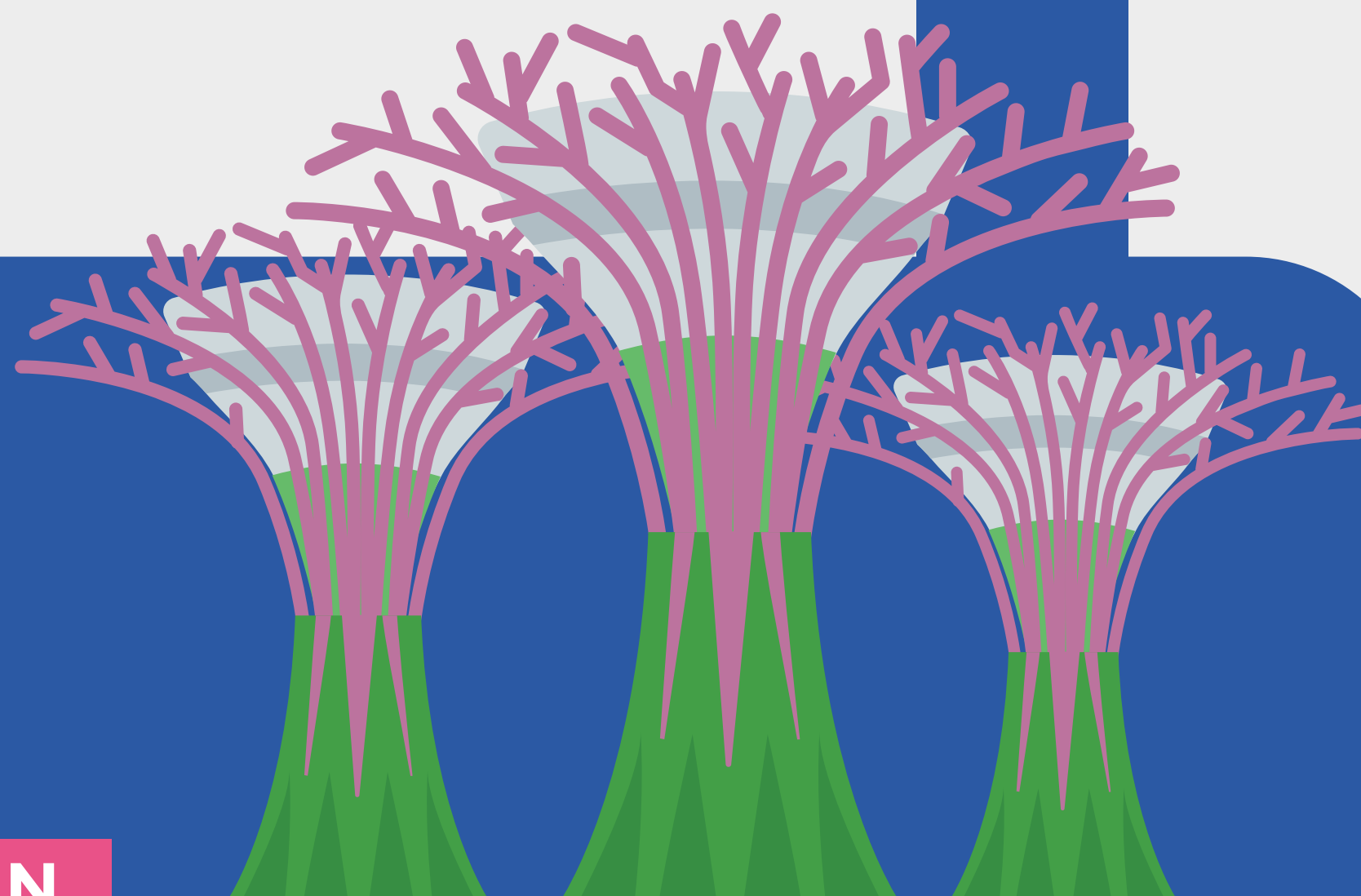

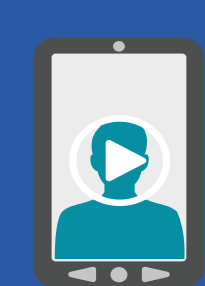

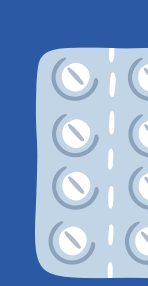
There are currently around 7,000 multi-national companies (MNCs) in Singapore, many with their Asian headquarters and global R&D labs here.



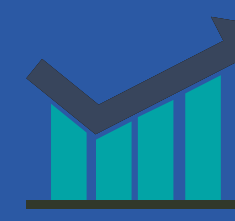
